

Jersey's **APPLEBY ACADEMY** players perform well at Derby 4 Star tournament.



- **Hugo Tupper wins Under 15 Boys' Grade 1 Singles** from an entry of 82 players dropping only one game in the knockout rounds.
- 13 year old Victoria Barnes in her first tournament off Island reaches the semi-final in the Under 15 Girls' Open beating England's No. 14 Kayleigh Forster in the quarter final coming back from 2--0 down to win 4 / 1 1, 4 / 1 1, 11 / 7, 11 / 9, 11 / 8.
- Kelsey le Maistre beats England No.37 Junior Helen Rutherford 3--1 in the first knockout round and took the No.7 Yolanda King all the way in the last 16 losing narrowly 8 / 11, 8 / 11, 8 / 11.
- Max Tupper, Hugo Tupper and Josh Band all reach the last 32 of the Under 18 Boys' Open which attracted some 90 players. Max was 2--1 down but came back strongly only to be denied by England No.17 Luca Mariano losing 2--3. Band had many chances too against England No.14 Ping Ho having lost the first game 5 / 11 to gain parity 11 / 6 but errors cost him the next two games being just edged out 11 / 13, 8 / 11 to lose 3--1.
- Jack Mills almost caused a major upset taking England No.6 Under 15 and third seed Adam Harrison to 5 games in the last 32 of the Under 15 Boys' Open having been 2--0 up to lose

agonisingly and undeservedly for his superb performance 11 / 9, 11 / 8, 10 / 12, 8 / 11, 5 / 11.

"All of our players recorded good wins against higher ranked opponents and it all combined to make it our most successful trip yet. Hugo won the same title that Josh Band won in 2008 and it is fantastic to see the trophy back in the Island again. All of the players can look forward to the forthcoming Jersey tournaments with high hopes of some really excellent results after their performances over the weekend," said JTТА President Chris Band.
