These are the rule changes proposed by the Rules committee From the 2008 JTТА handbook Page 19 - Regulations for Jersey Table Tennis Competitions

1.2.1 A player shall not be allowed to compete in the league, unless a registration form is completed, and the application has been approved by the ranking committee, followed by Council approval. In exceptional circumstances, the league secretary, in receipt of a registration form, may provisionally approve a person to play prior to a Council meeting being held.

1.2.1.1 All players who are members of Clubs using the GRTTC as their headquarters must be members of the Centre, except when acting as a reserve and taking the place of a fully paid up member of the GRTTC. Such reserves will not be required to pay a membership fee but will be subject to the approval requirements of 1.2.1, and will be required to pay the appropriate registration fee.

1.2.2.1 A member of an affiliated club may, subject to approval as detailed in 1.2.1, play as a reserve for up to a maximum of 4 matches in a season for a provisional fee for each match of one quarter of the annual registration fee.

1.2.2.2 Annual registration fees shall be in accordance with the Schedule of Fees in force at the time.

1.2.2.1.1 – delete section

We also propose to amend the look and feel of the way in which charges and fees are laid out in the rule book - but this does not affect any rules, fees or charges - it is just cosmetic.

2) Page 15 - Byelaws and Competition Regulations
